Respondents reported impacts ranging from negative (e.g.,50\% of fundraising organizations reporting a significant decrease in year-over-year funds raised) to positive (e.g., innovation, particularly around remote work). Most organizations reported a mix of positive and negative impacts.
"I would say 'both positive and negative.' Some positive impact on efficiency and culture, negative impact on fundraising and staff stress levels." - fundraising respondent
