### Government-University-Industry Research Roundtable

- Joint body of the National Academy of Sciences, National Academy of Engineering, and National Academy of Medicine
- Created in 1984 to convene senior-most representatives from government, university, and industry to define and explore critical issues related to the national and global science and technology agenda that are of shared interest and to frame the next critical question stemming from current debate and analysis
- Roundtable members convenes 3x yearly in Washington, DC
- Meetings designed around topics that are often newly emerging at the leadership level in one sector but impact/involve/affect other sectors
- Objective: To inject imaginative thought into the system and identify opportunities for better cross-sector collaboration in the pursuit of solutions to policy challenges


