


- Consulting services for design of high impact grantmaking

## Bridging the Divide: Two approaches



Goal of Awards Program – moving good ideas from the University towards commercialization

### 1. Catalyst Award

- > 1 year \$300,000
- > Benchmarks and Milestones towards proof of concept

#### 2. Transformational Award

- > Only open to recent Catalyst Awardees
- > Selection based on Catalyst achievements
- > 2 year, \$900,000 award



#### **Program related investments –**

IRS code allows certain investments to be classified as charitable disbursements

**Hood** is investing in startups with child health focus:

- Non-invasive oxygen monitoring for neonates
- Inexpensive, rugged, testing for HIV drug resistance
- Inexpensive disposable neonatal incubators
