





MRA Team Science Awards

- Multidisciplinary collaboration between two or more established PIs plus a Young Investigator* with complementary expertise that offers the possibility for synergistic advances.
- Typically \$800,000-\$1 million total over 3 years
- Periodic "Special Opportunities" with different/more specific requirements

^{*}within 4 years of first faculty appointment



Benefits and Challenges


- Benefits of teams:
 - Collaboration
 - Multidisciplinary science
 - Build the field



- Challenges of teams:
 - Financial risk: Large investment over short timeline
 - Administrative
 - Leadership

Synergy v. Additivity

- Performance
 - Quantitative output
 - Follow-on funding
 - Publications
 - Impact on field



Matchmaking



- Team composition restricted/specified in RFP
- Post-review matchmaking ("arranged marriage")

Recommendations

- Demonstrate "team-ness" in applications
- 3 year award duration
- 60 day timeframe for sub-awards
- Avoid post-review matchmaking
