

- Program launched in 2018
- Large-scale, interdisciplinary research partnerships to address major scientific challenges
- Research that "lifts all boats."



LBD Biomarker Initiative

5-year, \$5M initiative to find a biomarker for LBD

Timeline:

- · 2018 2019: Concept development
- · 2018 2023: Fundraising
- · 2021: RFP and recipient selection
- · 2022: First grants to recipients
- · 2023: Fundraising goal met
- · 2024: Round 2 RFP and recipient selection









Neuroinflammation Initiative

\$10M, multi-year effort to understand neuroinflammation as an underlying mechanism of brain disease and brain health.
